The company successfully competes in niche industry segments such as industrial wood and metal work machinery and satellite antenna tacking devices.

Speaking about the company, Joe O' Donovan (MD) says "At Callan Technology, we believe it is important to continually keep looking forward in order to be able to identify new opportunities. Just recently we have worked with a postal sorting machine manufacturer in Germany, where we were able to provide them with our motors to achieve their target.
